COMMUNICATIONS

RECEIVED COPY OF ARCADIA-NEWARK COM-PREHENSIVE PLAN 1. Arcadia-Newark Comprehensive Plan: On December 19, the Town Clerk received a "Project Notification and SEQR Lead Agency Designation for the Arcadia-Newark Comprehensive Plan." Town of Palmyra, as a bordering town to Arcadia, and therefore an "Interested Agency," received a copy of the Comprehensive Plan Summary, required by law. It is available for review at the Town Clerk's office for anyone interested in doing so.

2. <u>SMSI Grant Agreements:</u> The agreements for all three heavy equipment purchases have been signed by all parties of the four participating municipalities and have been returned to us. These signed agreements will be filed in the Town Clerk's office. Mike Boesel added that all equipment has been ordered, and should be here within 120 days.

Ken Miller reported that work had begun under the Town Hall floor on the South side of the building. Brad Jacobs had found standing water at the southwest corner after the padded insulation was removed. He installed fans for a number of days and found marked improvement. He then painted three coats of waterproofing sealer on the inside of the outer wall under the floor. He is pleased with the way the moisture is now sealed out. To avoid standing water pooling there in the future, he recommends building a "crock" in the dirt floor. Ken will talk with Brad to get it done. The next step will be to scrape off the mold from underneath the floorboards and to coat them with a mold sealer paint.

In addition, the Board asked Mike Boesel if the downspouts had been plugged with debris in the gutters or with ice from the last snowstorm. Mike said he'd try to snake the downspouts to determine any blockage.

Highway Committee – James Welch, Chairman

1. Wayne County Snow/Ice Control: Three copies of the 2008-2009 Winter Season Agreement for Snow and Ice Control on County Roads was provided to Board members. Highway Superintendent Mike Boesel said this year AGREEMENT FOR there is a change in the payment based on time and material, rather than a lump sum as in the past. He feels the Town of Palmyra will come out about even.

2. Town/County Signage Grant: A copy of the Resolution to apply to the NYS Department of State for a Local Government Efficiency Grant for the Wayne County Signage Program was given to each Board member. Fifteen towns were part of a REPLACE SIGNAGE signage study for updated and standardized signs in Wayne AROUND WAYNE County. Now, the County is applying to the State for a Local Government Efficiency Implementation Grant to replace or update signs that need to be done. Each Town must pass the resolution for the grant to be submitted.

3. December Highway Department Report: Mike Boesel provided Town Board members a Highway Department report:

Since the 11/20/08 meeting we have completed the following work:

- Brushmowing Walker Road, Floodman Road
- Snowfence Installation around most of Town
- Trucks/Equipment maintenance
- Inter-municipal Assistance 9/5/08 – 11/19/08 Palmyra grader returned from Wayne Co. Hwy 11/19.
- Plowing/Sanding We had one of the busiest Decembers in a long time. In the past 40 days we have made a total of 41 trips out of the barn. At this time last year we had made 31 trips.

- SMSI Grant 07-08 All equipment has been ordered and should arrive in less than 120 days.
 - LGE Grant 08-09 –We decided against submitting a grant this time around.
 I'll be watching/waiting for any 2009-2010 grant opportunities under this program.
 - Winter Preparations Most of our snowfence has been installed. With the number of trips we have made out of the barn, we are working on the trucks and equipment on a daily basis.

DECEMBER HIGHWAY REPORT

- Treework As time and weather permits throughout the winter we will be performing some treework on our roads and some brushmowing.
- Flooding With the 50+-degree temperatures we experienced over the weekend coupled with the rain and the huge snowmelt, Hogback Road between N. Creek and Galloway (Swifts Landing Park area) was flooded. I closed the road at 6:30am on Sunday 11/28 and re-opened it at 5:30am Monday 11/29. There was no apparent damage to the roadway. There were no other drainage issues in the Town.
- Equipment
 - Loader Bid We budgeted for replacement of our existing loader in the 2009 budget. If we are to do this, we need to be out to bid soon in order to have a new loader before our May Auction.
