The following resolution was adopted with but one dissenting vote—Resolved –That \$300 be raised by a tax on the taxable property of the town to be disbursed by and under the direction of the Commissioners of Highways of said town towards straightening and grading the highway over Hog-Back hill from near Anson Hilimire residence? thirty to Amherst C. Beal's premises.
