12. <u>Set Date for Audit of 2015 Town Financial Books:</u> Mike Lambrix made the motion to have two board members visit each of the Town Court Justice Office, the Town Clerk's office, and the Supervisors office, and to be assigned and given the audit checklists by January 28, 2016. The board members that audit the offices would then present their findings at the February 25, 2016 meeting.

13. <u>Establish Rate for Mileage Re-imbursement</u>: Mike Lambrix made the motion to approve the current mileage re-imbursement of \$.55 per mile.

14. Appoint: Board Representative to Wayne County Cable TV Council: Mike Lambrix made the motion to appoint Ken Miller as representative to the Wayne County Cable TV Council.

15. Approve: Purchase of BAS Software and Services: After discussion of the brand and details of the BAS software and services, Mike Lambrix made the motion to approve the purchase of the BAS Software and Services for use in the Code Enforcement Office, as quoted in the Integrated Property System Quote, not to exceed \$15,600.00, and to allow the Supervisor to sign the agreement. Jim Welch seconded the motion. This is a budgeted purchase. A roll call vote was asked for by the Supervisor.

It was further explained that there is currently an \$1800.00 annual fee that includes service and any upgrades.

16. Approve: Updated Fee Schedule: After discussion with the Code Enforcement Officer Pat Sheridan regarding the projection of fees to be collected, and the escrow fee of \$150.00 that will be collected for building permits, Mike Lambrix made the motion to approve the updated fee schedule in the Code Enforcement Office to take effect on February 1st, 2016.

17. Approve: Purchase of Mowing Tractor: Jim Welch made the motion to approve the purchase of a 2015 - 6105 JD Tractor with 2 yr. warranty, not to exceed \$110,000.00. Discussion ensued in regards to used tractors that were also available. Ultimately, Mr. Boesel stated that he thought that after much research, and after inspecting the tractor, the warranted tractor for \$110,000.00 would be the best choice, and that he anticipates getting 14-16yrs of use out of it. Mr. Welch repeated the motion for this budgeted purchase. Brad Cook seconded the motion. The Supervisor requested a roll call vote.

- **18.** <u>Approve: Change in Employee Handbook:</u> This change had been tabled at the previous meeting, and the Supervisor asked that it remained tabled at this time.
- **19**. Approve: Cost of Demolition of 4775 Tellier Rd: Mike Lambrix made the motion to accept the cost of demolition of 4775 Tellier Rd., not to exceed \$22,000.00. It is noted that this is an emergency situation, and that the cost will be added to the property owner's taxes.

20. Approve: Accept Possible Responsibility for Congdon Trust: Mike Lambrix made the motion to accept funds that may be left in the Congdon Fund only if the Palmyra Kings Daughter's, Inc. is no longer able or willing to accept this trust, to be used solely to erect a memorial to honor Palmyra's WWI veterans in the Sexton Park, with the cost of such monument being only what is left of said trust. The Town Clerk further explained the situation, and reassured the Town Board that the Village Board agreed to allow this to be built at the Sexton Park, if necessary, at their January 4th, 2016 meeting.

21. <u>Approve: Letter Indicating that the town Accepts Responsibility for Congdon Fund:</u> Mike Lambrix made the motion to approve the Supervisor to sign the letter to JP Morgan Chase Bank indicating that the town would accept responsibility for Congdon Fund if needed. (ATTACHEMENT E)
