COMMUNICATIONS

1. Wayne County Fair Request: A letter from the Union Agricultural Society at Palmyra was received inquiring about PARTICIPATION IN Town Officials' participation in the Wayne County Fair Parade on August 14, 2009, at 7 p.m. After brief discussion, Town Board members decided they would like to participate, and directed the Town Clerk to notify Fair officials of the decision.

2. Project Sunlight Presentation: An email was received on April 22 about a new program at the State level called Project PROJECT SUNLIGHT PRESENTATION BY ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE STAFF MEMBER Sunlight. The New York State Attorney General's office is promoting a citizen's "right to know and to monitor governmental decision-making." Debra Martin, from the Attorney General's office in Rochester, briefly outlined the new project for those in attendance. The Town Clerk made copies of the SunlightNY.com website information for Board members. "It allows you to easily access statewide government information that until now has been scattered and difficult to retrieve."

3. Program About Safe Digging: A fax was received inviting Board members to a free presentation on May 3rd, in Waterloo, concerning "valuable information about digging, the One-Call system, hazards of underground utilities", underground damage prevention and safe digging. Board members are encouraged to attend.

4. "Let's Go Hike and Bike" Program: We received a letter from Wayne County Tourism about a new hiking and biking program for the Finger Lakes Region. Hikers and bikers receive a stack of cards, each containing information about a particular place of interest in the Finger Lakes region. The program encourages the hikers and bikers to travel along the roads and trails to each location and to collect the full set of cards. Hikers and bikers like the cards because each one tells about the location they have traveled to, making it educational as well as recreational.

BUILDINGS & GROUNDS REPORT

Ken Miller reported that Village groundsmen have done Spring cleanup work at Town Hall. Flower beds have been mulched, grass has been mowed, trimming and edging have been done, and the landscaping around the building looks fresh and well-maintained.

In addition, the Palmyra Highway crew came to Town Hall and cleared gutters and downspouts around the building, finding many to have been plugged up partially, or totally. In addition, they did several tests on the cleaned downspouts to find out where they empty into underground sewer lines. None of this information had been passed on to the Town when the building was purchased.

Highway Committee – James Welch, Chairman

1. <u>April Highway Department Report:</u> Mike Boesel provided Town Board members a Highway Department Report:

Highway Superintendent Report for Town Board Meeting April 23, 2009

Since the 3/26/09 meeting we have completed the following work:

- Trucks/Equipment maintenance and inspections completed
- Pothole patching all roads reviewed several times in past month
- Hauling hauled washed 1A stone for surface treating later this summer
- Plowing/Sanding –In the past 29 days we have made a total of <u>1 trip</u> out of the barn. Season to date we have made <u>93 trips</u> out of the barn. At this time <u>last year</u> we had made <u>99 trips</u>.

APRIL HIGHWAY REPORT

Other miscellaneous items include:

- SMSI Grant 07-08 I submitted to the NYS DOS for our 90% reimbursement money for the bucket truck and street sweeper on 4/8/09. We should be receiving our reimbursement money soon. Our new excavator is not expected to be delivered for a few more weeks.
- Street Sweeping/Yard Cleanup We completed all snow plow damage/lawn repairs this past month.
- Roadside Damages During the week of 4/13 to 4/17 we found road damages to Hogback Road. Pictures were taken and forwarded to the Town Attorney for advisement. Repair costs are still being evaluated.
- Stop Ahead Signs I am in the process of reviewing the current locations of all our Stop Ahead signs. These signs need to be replaced and the advance posting distance re-evaluated to current standards

- 1987 Case 1085B Drott Sale At the last meeting we declared our 1987 Case 1085B drott as surplus and placed this item on Roy Teitsworth, Inc. 1-week online auction sale from 4/8 to 4/15. The bidding closed at 6pm on 4/15 with a final bid of \$14,808.00. We accepted this bid on 4/16.
- **Palmyra Municipal Auction** We are busy preparing the highway grounds for the upcoming May 9th event. WATS will continue to provide shuttle service between the Garlock parking lot and the event. I have attached a revised list of highway equipment items to declare surplus for inclusion in the Auction.

APRIL HIGHWAY REPORT

- On 4/21/09 Mike Paul and I attended a 4-hour Erosion & Sediment Control training course hosted by Wayne County Soil & Water at the Macedon Town Hall.
- On 4/28 & 4/29 the entire crew will have safety training on the new bucket truck purchase.

- Highway School early registration is due by 5/22 (\$90) for the June 1-3 event.

- Bobcat Purchase We received our new 2009 Bobcat on 4/3.
- Equipment Servicing Over the past month, all trucks and plow equipment have been washed/painted/waxed and trucks converted over for 'summer' uses including tarps re-installed.
